

PLAYING WITH FIRE

Speed Dating Details

Eligibility

- Ladies must be at least 21 years of age to be a Speed Dater.
- Must register online and pre-pay prior to the event. Once we receive your completed registration and payment, we'll send you an e-mail confirmation.
- All names, phone number, and email information will be kept confidential and only released as indicated in this document. By registering for this event you are allowing us permission to release limited information as indicated below under The Speed Dating Game section.
- There is limited seating to this event (**125%*see waiting list below). If the event is booked, you will be put on a waiting list for the next PLAYING WITH FIRE speed-dating event. You will not be automatically registered, but will be on the list. The price and location of future speed-dating events have not been determined.

The Speed Dating Game: we provide the date, you provide the results!

- Check in begins at 4:00 pm. All Speed Daters must be checked-in and present at Slainte Irish Pub by 4:45. The event begins at 5 p.m. sharp.
- Waiting List: This list may be used if a registered Speed Dater does not check in by 4:45. You must be present and on time at Slainte Irish Pub to be pulled from the waiting list.
- Speed Daters will be given a welcome pack consisting of a name tag (first name only) with an assigned number. Food and drink tickets will also be provided (as always, drink responsibly).
- By the start of the event, all speed daters will put on their name-tags.
- You will have 3 minutes at each table to chat and ask questions; HAVE FUN!
- Each 3-minute date begins with the sound of a Fire Bell !
- At the end of the 3 minutes, a fire engine siren will sound.
- Once the siren has sounded, the ladies will have approx 30 seconds to move to the next table and mark their score cards (mark yes, if you'd prefer to see that person again or mark no, if not interested); the firemen will be marking as well. Also, please answer the question about the speed dater's courtesy and politeness during the 3 minutes exchange.
- Marking your scorecard is not to be marked during the 3 minute date – wait until the date is over and mark discretely. DO NOT SHARE YOUR SELECTION/ANSWERS.
- This process will continue until all the ladies have met each of the firemen.
- When the ladies have met each of the firemen, all score-cards will be turned in to the event organizer.
- After the event, you will receive an e-mail indicating any perfect matches (meaning you both checked yes on the Score Card) with the only the first name and e-mail address of each perfect match.
- Please allow at least a week for this email to arrive.
- From there, it is up to the both of you to contact one another.
- All participants will receive an e-mail regardless of their match status. If for some reason you do not receive one, contact the event organizer at playingwithfireAIFF@gmail.com.

Rules

- No skipping tables or leaving a table prior to the siren.
- No phone numbers, addresses or emails will be exchanged during the game.
- Do not disclose your last name.
- All conversations, follow-ups and subsequent contacts are the sole responsibility of the Speed Daters. The event organizers, Slainte Irish Pub, All In for Firefighters and the Professional Firefighters and Paramedics Benevolent Fund, Inc., Gordon and Doner are not responsible for any Speed Dater's actions during or after the event.
- By registering for this event, you acknowledge, understand and accept the above rules and requirements.

6. If you knew you'd be financially taken care of for the next year, what would you do with your time or where would you go?
7. What's the most adventurous thing you've ever done?
8. What's the best concert you've ever been to?
